- Camp Wellness is designed to be a combination of UU Youth Cons and summer camps, pulling ideas and structure from each. It is designed for youth ages 12 – 18, but it is possible to accept youth outside of that age range with permission from the coordinators. Workshops will include poetry writing, backpacking / survival skills, social justice organizing, safer sex practices, and techniques for managing depression, among others.
- Camp will take place at SAWUURA, a primitive site in the Sierra Ancha Wilderness of the Tonto National Forest between Payson and Globe, AZ. There is a solar heated shower at the site and pit toilets.
- Camp will officially begin on Monday May 25 at 2p after Memorial Day Weekend Camping (please visit the SAWUURA website to find out about this family camping opportunity) and end at 1p on Saturday May 31, 2014. Youth can arrive or leave at times other than those stated but these must be approved by the coordinators.
- The cost of camp is \$100. This includes all meals for the week. There is work-trade available to lessen the cost of camp (amount determined based on stated need.) Work-trade can be either manual labor work on the grounds or help in the kitchen depending on youth abilities. If youth is unable to perform these functions then scholarships may be discussed. We do not want any youth to be turned away from camp due to lack of funds. Adult volunteers do not need to pay for camp. Parent volunteers are given a single \$25 waiver to put towards their child(ren)s' attendance at camp.
